

# Make Tracks to Bear Country U.S.A.

Since 1972 visitors have enjoyed a leisurely drive through this unique and spectacular wildlife park. **Bear Country U.S.A.** features many species of North American animals, including the largest privately owned collection of American Black Bear. Observe elk, wolves, reindeer, buffalo, big horn sheep, rocky mountain goats, mountain lions and other wildlife from the comfort of your own vehicle. The animals roam free in 200 acres of natural Black Hills habitat.



Park and then stroll around the Wildlife Walkway and see smaller animals and the bear cubs! **Bear Country U.S.A.** is home to over 25 species. The exciting, enjoyable and educational encounters you experience will last a lifetime.



## • Park Rules •

- All persons entering this wildlife park do so at their own risk to person and property and will be in full view of the Observation Tower to monitor their safety and the safety of the wild animals.
- All persons must remain in their vehicle at all times with all doors and sunroofs tightly closed.
- Windows must be closed at all times.
- Feeding of animals is strictly prohibited.
- Should you develop car trouble, do not attempt to leave your vehicle. Turn on your hazard lights and sound your horn to summon assistance.
- Commercial rights to all photographs remain the property of Bear Country U.S.A.
- No pets around Wildlife Walkway Loop.
- No selfie sticks inside the animal pens.
- Do not reach selfie sticks into pens.

### Wildlife Walkway

On the 1/4 mile Wildlife Walkway Loop, soothing waterfalls greet you along the trail as you enjoy carefully kept educational exhibits including the **Discovery Den** with hands-on activities and a display to see animals up close. Along the **Loop** you will see more than a dozen different species of smaller animals. Halfway through the **Loop** you will delight in the antics of our charming bear cubs! Shuttle service is available for guests with mobility concerns.

Don't return to your vehicle hungry! Enjoy ice cream, cold drinks and tasty eats at the **Cub Grub Snack Shack**.

### The Bear's Den

This remarkable 6,000 square foot gift shop is one of the most unique in the Black Hills. Many wildlife treasures and gifts are available to visitors who love animals, nature and the great outdoors.

### Groups, Tours, Guide & Courtesy Car Information

- "Group" must be designated and identifiable, and must include at least fifteen people.
- Children under the age of five in a private family vehicle are admitted free.
- Step-on guides are available without charge for a motorcoach, and with a 24-hour advance notice of arrival. Approximate tour time: 2 hours. Special motorcoach parking with clear access to exit is available.
- Special rates are available for professional photographers and artists.
- Courtesy cars are available for motorcyclists.

Bear Country U.S.A. is open from late April to late November. Peak season (June, July, August) hours are 8am to 6pm daily. Shoulder season hours are 9am to 4pm. We are open every day during the season. 8 miles south of Rapid City on Highway 16, on the Road to Mt. Rushmore.
